The INPsySR will sponsor a number of symposia at the ECP 2011 in Turkey. We invite submissions of abstracts for presentations, panels or workshop activities on any topic related to our aims. We aim to provide a forum for researchers, practitioners, activists and humanitarian workers engaged in the field of peace psychology to meet, be heard and exchange ideas and experiences with each other.

The INPsySR will gather these proposals into symposia around a theme. These symposia will then be proposed for the Ethics track - Psychology Ethics around the World - Challenges and Opportunities. This track will ideally enable attendees to follow specific ethics-related discussions that will be presented in a well-organized and coherent fashion. Ideally, presentations in the ethics track will build upon one another and suggest possibilities for future collaboration.

Abstracts (150 words) should summarize the purpose, method, results and discussion of the study or present a coherent argument with regard to the workshop or panel discussion (15 minutes presentation + 5 minutes Q&A).

To be considered for INPsySR symposia the abstracts must be sent to Jancis Long, (jancislong2004@yahoo.com) by **17th of December 2010**. We will send you word of your inclusion in our symposia as quickly as possible. If we cannot include it, you will have the possibility of sending it directly to the Congress by their deadline, 31st of December 2010.
